God has blessed our family in so many ways while I have served as the associate pastor of Calvary Baptist Church. In June of 2006, we celebrated our ten-year anniversary as a local New Testament church. Many of our government officials, chiefs, friends, and co-workers graced the wonderful occasion. We thank God for the many people who received the Lord as their personal Savior, including one of the sub-chiefs sent as a delegate from the King of Techiman.



The theme of our Faith Promise Missions conference in October was "Giving of our best to the Lord." We invited four missionaries. Three of the four were Liberians who believe that God is calling them back to rebuild the broken war-torn churches of Liberia. The other missionary was Pastor Sarfo Adu Stephen, a recent graduate of CBTS, who we hope to send to pastor the new church in Oforikrom and Boankron.

For the past two years, I was been working with both Pastor Atta Korang and Pastor Stephen Kyeremeh to start a church in these villages. We have been holding Tuesday afternoon visitation, Bible studies, and prayer meeting with them in their village. On Sunday mornings, we transport them to Techiman to worship with us until God enables us to build a building in their village.

Our immediate goal for the church is to be able to put up a bigger church building which can seat about one thousand people. We are estimating that the new building may cost about \$100,000. Please pray with us trusting that nothing is impossible for our God to do.

We have been experiencing some problems with our landlady, even though she took another years rent, expiring on August 2007. She has asked us to leave the house by the end of January 2007. Please, pray with us as we seek the Lord's immediate provision for housing, and help in building a house on our own land just beside the church. With a gift from a brother in the Heritage Baptist Church in Michigan, we have been able to begin the work. We hope to be able to put up a humble home by the end of this year.

This year, one of the greatest blessings for me was God blessing the successful spinal surgery for my dear wife, Vester. We praise Him for the financial helps we received through our loved ones to meet all the huge bills for Vester's surgery and medical care. We have always trusted in His provision. According to the neurosurgeon, an M.R.I test will be conducted on February 8, and the results will determine whether a second surgery will be done to infuse a metal spacer to replace the third vertebrae which had been destroyed by the Tuberculosis. That vertebrae was removed during the first surgery. Please pray with us.
