This past year has been a year of FIRSTS. It was our first Ladies Bible Institute graduation. Eight ladies graduated with four ladies completing the two-year program and four ladies completing the three-year program. This year four new ladies have entered into the Bible Institute. To God be the glory! Teaching these ladies is a blessing to me.

It was the year of our first church built along the Sunyani Road. Our first church is built between the villages of Faaman and Bonkwai. Pastor Atta Takyi is doing a fine job as pastor. Eventually, we would like to see other churches planted in the village of Nkwaeso and one in Nsuta. Our village ministry takes in about 18Km and ten villages. Visitation to these ten villages takes much time, but the Lord is blessing our ministry.

I am in charge of the ladies and children's ministries in the church and in these villages. In Children's church Pastor Atta's wife, Afia, teaches the younger children while I teach the older ones. Weekly, Afia has 35 to 50 children, and I have 75 to 80 children. I also have weekly Bible clubs in some of these villages. Monthly, we have a Ladies Fellowship in the church.

In November, we started a youth ministry with the youth of our church. Visitation is a very important part of my ministry. The Lord is blessing my ministry as we see more people put their faith in Christ for salvation.

It was a first for having Teacher Training Classes in two of our churches. I have also been preparing lessons for both Mrs. Gyamfi's village ministry along the Kumasi Road and for Naomi Addai's children church ministry in the northern Ghana. Both Mrs. Gyamfi and Mrs. Addai are graduates from the Bible Institute.

Future Plans:

This year I wanted to build a house in Faaman. Living among our people will give me a greater chance to reach out to them and to other villages behind our villages. There is much to be done for the Gospel.

Needs:

We need \$250 for benches or chairs for the church. We need study Bibles for the Ladies' Bible Institute. We need another bus to pick up people for the Sunday morning service, (a used one runs around \$10,000).
