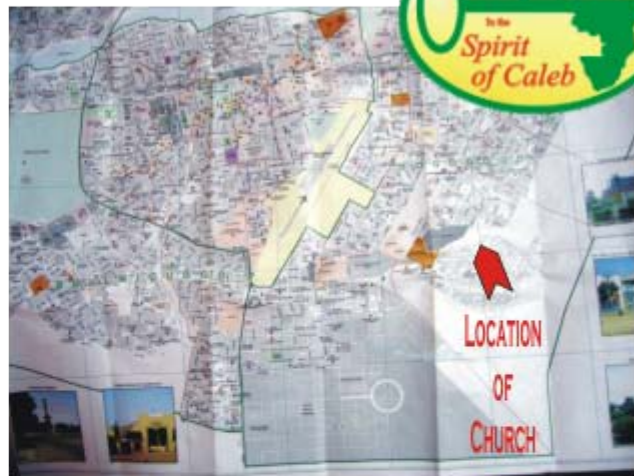


Spirit Of Caleb In The 10/40 Window
