



All glory must be given to God for the things he has done for us. This past year has been a very special year, because after visiting more than 130 churches we safely arrived in Ghana in July. We have been granted a one year stay permit, while we apply for our missionary residences permits.

We are currently serving in Techiman, under the ministry of Calvary Baptist Church. We thank the Lord for Pastor Stephen Volante and his family for giving

us the opportunity to serve with them. It was through their ministry that God opened the door for us to work here in Ghana, where I am serving as the youth pastor. We have seen God work in the youth group through the visitation and the weekly activities. Next year we plan to start a special class for all the young people that have been called into the ministry. We rejoice to see what the Lord has done during this year's camp at the Calvary Baptist International School. Over 350 students were challenged by every message preached to them. During this week 54 people received Christ as their personal Savior and many decided to serve the Lord full time. God has given us much fruit in the Saturday children's Bible Club of the church. Now at least 40 of them have started attending Sunday school. On Wednesdays we have Bible club with 70 to 80 children and teenagers.



My wife is helping in the women's fellowship of Bonkwai and she is also teaching the Sunday evening children class at the Techiman church, Please pray with us for the Lord's direction this coming year for our new ministry location. God has put a special burden in our hearts to plan churches in the Central Region of Ghana. Especially in the city of Cape Coast which is just two hours away from the capital city, Accra. Join us in prayer as we look for God's timing. We also ask you to pray with us that the Lord will provide for an increase in our personal support, and that more churches will start supporting us now that



we are on the field.

As we planned to move from the house that we are currently living in, (which was lent to us by missionary Susan Oppenheimer) we will face many new expenses. But, we trust that the Lord will richly supply all our needs as He has promised. Thank you for your faithful prayers and financial support.
