

HOPE INTERNATIONAL SENIOR HIGH SCHOOL



Year after year as our precious children complete their course of study in our junior high school, we painfully watch them enroll in many secular and “religious” boarding schools because we have no high school level education to offer them. We have been praying and planning toward the day when we could offer our students a Christ-centered education at the high school level. Lord willing, if all the necessary improvements are completed on time, and the teaching staff is in order, we plan to open the Hope International Senior High School in September of 2011 (AKA. HIS School). HIS school will require much more infrastructure and staff than our primary and junior high because it will be both a day and boarding school. We want to be able to accommodate children from nearby cities that have only secular high schools as well as from towns and villages near us that currently have no high school at all. Like the C.B.I.S. most all of the HIS School students will be financially supported by their own parents ‘except’ for those students receiving a Hope Scholarship. The Hope Scholarship has three main goals. First, we want to offer 25-30 scholarships each year to needy children in key cities and

villages where we are planning to start new churches praying that these children will provide open doors into their communities. Second, we want to provide an excellent Christ-centered education that will attract the leaders of our society to entrust their children’s education in our hands, thus giving us opportunities to lead them to Christ in Chapel and Bible classes. Third, we want to keep our own children unspotted by the world and fully equipped for every good work for the Lord. During school vacations, we plan to take the Hope Scholarship children (and other articulate Christian students) on a ministry tour to their individual home towns to display their academic achievements along with a clear presentation of the gospel. We believe this special ministry will impact hundreds if not thousands of lives for Christ. Each Hope Scholarship will cost \$50 per month and will last for 4 years.
