CHILDREN AND YOUTH MINISTRY is an important part of the ministry here in Bonkwai. Many are saved through this ministry and grow in the knowledge of His Word.

My goals for this year are to see many put their faith in Christ for salvation and to teach and train the nationals of Ghana to serve and live lives honoring to the Lord. As a church we also want to build a permanent children's & youth structure at the church in Bonkwai to accommodate this growing ministry.

With our pastor, I am burdened and believe it is time for us to reach out and start a church in Nsuta while visitors from Nsuta are coming to Bonkwai and are interested in having their own church. Nsuta is a much larger village than Bonkwai and would be a great place to have a strong church.



I came to Ghana on August 24, 2002, to teach and train others to serve the Lord and to carry on the ministry in the local church.

THE LADIES BIBLE INSTITUTE in Techiman: In January, we started the year with 25 ladies studying the Word of God. However, by the end of the year, we had only 19 ladies. This is due to some who have to travel to purchase things to sell in the market, some because of medical problems, and some because of giving birth, (Here the ladies stay in the home for 3 months after giving birth).

Our LADIES FELLOWSHIP in Bonkwai: Though our ladies are poor and many are uneducated, it is a joy to teach them from God's Word and to apply spiritual truths to their lives. Some of the ladies are now serving the Lord through helping and teaching in the children's ministries, going on visitation, and cleaning and caring for the church.

VISITATION into nearby villages introduces many to the Savior for salvation. One man after trusting in Christ was immediately concerned about the salvation of his wife and children. He is now a faithful member of the church in Bonkwai. Every Tuesday 2 young ladies, Pearle and Gloria, go on

visitation with me. I appreciate their faithfulness and desire to serve the Lord Jesus Christ. They are now teaching in the children's ministry.
